



Proposed PMN Constitution Changes for the 2022 AGM

The following changes to the PMN Constitution version 26/10/2021 are proposed by the Pastoral Ministry Network Management Committee (27 July 2022 meeting) to the 2022 AGM:

2.f.	Fix typo	liaising with organisations which have a particular interest in pastoral ministry, including laity advocate organisations and movements;
2.h.	Amend to expand the range to cover Oceania	liaising with the Australian Catholic B bishops in Australia and Oceania;
2.i.	Amend to expand the range to cover Oceania	liaising with Institutes and Societies of Consecrated Life in the Catholic Religious Australia and Oceania.
3.2	Reword to streamline method for registration and cover shifting 12 month registration period	Application for membership shall be in writing, either through the Association website (or by completing a Membership Application Form) such as in an email, registering as a member at an Association event, or by subscribing to the quarterly Association Newsletter. ... The application for membership shall be accompanied by the annual membership fee effective in the financial year the application is made. for 12 months from the date of application.
3.3	New	A copy of this Constitution will be made available to all members on the Association website for download, or by other means. By seeking new/continued membership to the Association, members agree to the provisions of this Constitution.
6.2	Amend to cover shifting 12-month period	Annual membership fees are due on 1 January of every year. payable on commencement of membership and at renewal of membership at the rate applicable at that time.
11.2	New To limit the number of terms of office	Only in exceptional circumstances, and on acceptance by the members present prior to voting at the MC Election, no member shall hold a position on the management committee beyond three consecutive terms.
